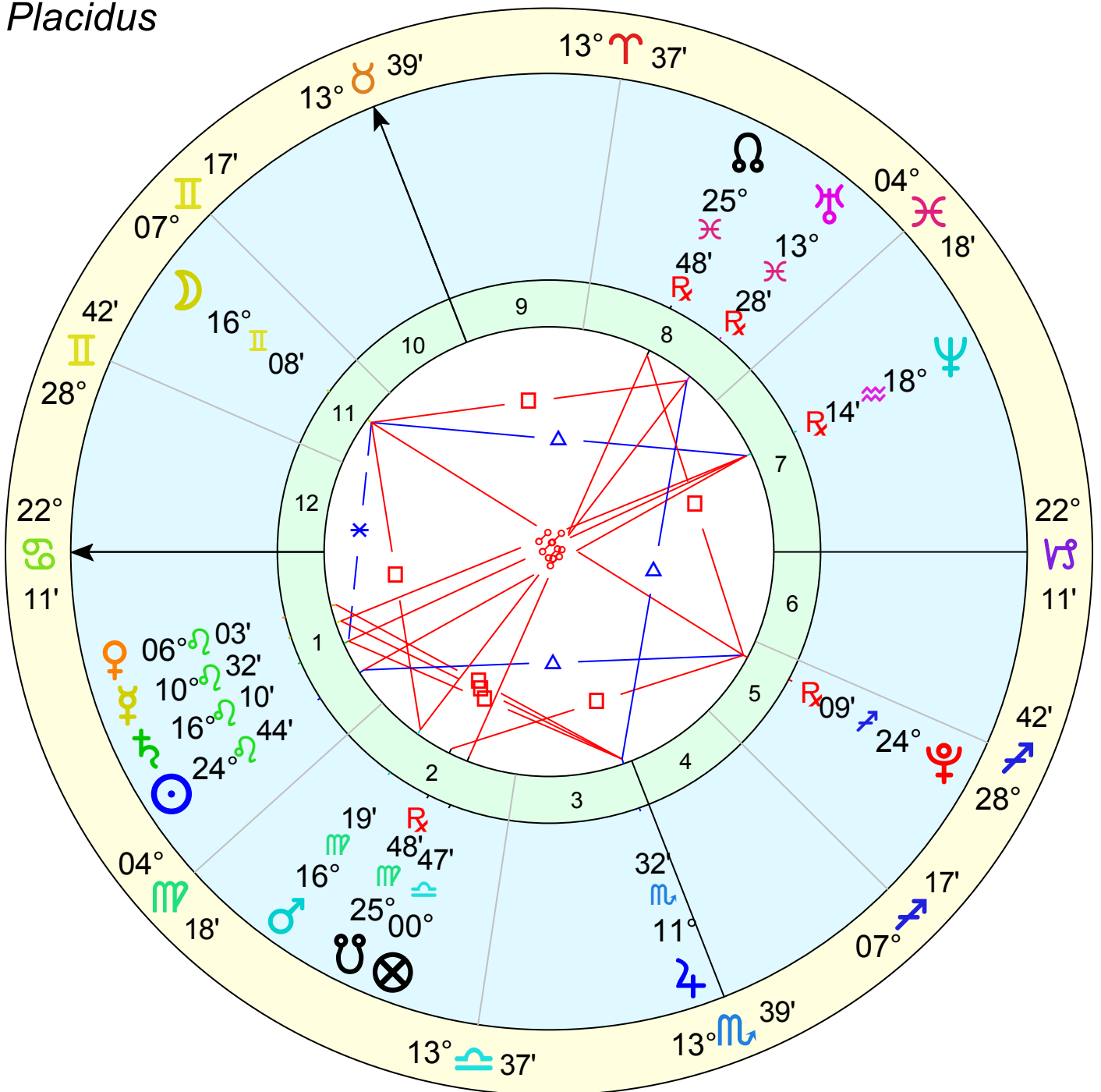

INTRODUCTION
